Terry Gerlich, SEI present to discuss Q1 Performance for 2021, and long-term expectations. Gerlich reviewed the portfolio highlights of a 5.7% return for the quarter and a +40.3% return on a trailing 1-year basis, generating more than \$140M in gains over the last 12 months as of 03/31/21. SEI's strategy of sticking with the fundamentals have been rewarded. While this is good news, he warns that the theme for 2021 will be protection against inflation. Their core property managers have been overweight in the industrial sector and that worked well for the portfolio this year. SEI's believes 2021 will continue to see strong earnings in equities and do not expect fixed income to move much. The debate on inflation will continue to cause market volatility.
