### **POB Discussion** (1:25-1:45)

Deputy Chief of Staff, Nelson Fernandez, and CFO, Troy Clarkson present to discuss the POB, and FY 27 appropriation.

The CFO presented the Board with a schedule for the Pension Obligation Bond issuance. The expectation is that the Board will receive \$59 million June 1. The Chair asked what happens if the issuance is late? He warned that the Board will have to send a letter to the City as they already have accepted only the normal cost for 2026 and the System earned 15% in returns this year, that is lost opportunity cost. The CFO acknowledged and thanked the Board for working with the City to assist them during the budget crunch. He stated that they plan on giving the Board the \$59M to help fund the UAL and will pay the Board the full FY 27 appropriation, not just the normal cost.

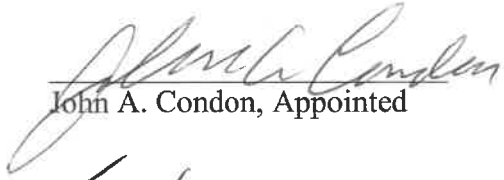
